Yamazaki 12-Year-Old February's featured whisky

Known as “the pioneer of Japanese whisky” Yamazaki is Japan’s first and oldest distillery - established in 1923 on the periphery of Kyoto. The Yamazaki 12 year-old has been becoming harder to find as it’s popularity grows. This whisky offers a characteristically refined Japanese taste, distinguished by an aroma of ripened fruit and a sweet vanilla fragrance.

Nose: Peach, pineapple, grapefruit, clove, candied orange, vanilla, Mizunara (Japanese oak)

Palate: Coconut, cranberry, butter

Finish: Sweet ginger, cinnamon, long finish

Awards: Double Gold Medal- San Francisco World Spirits Competition 2018 & 2013; Gold Medal- San Francisco World Spirits Competition 2014 & 2011.



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
